**Expression of interest - student member on the
University Committee on Environmental Sustainability**

Dear students,

The University Committee on Environmental Sustainability provides advice to the Vice-Chancellor on environmental matters related to the development of the University's campuses and surrounds; the implementation and maintenance of environmentally sensitive and sustainable practices; and strategies to build environmental awareness across the University and its communities. The Committee meets 4 times per year.

The Committee has provision for two student members who are appointed by the Vice-Chancellor following a call for expressions of interest. A vacancy currently exists for one (1) student member.

Students who would like to submit an expression of interest for the vacancy should prepare a statement no longer than 150 words containing:

- your student number
- a short outline of your interest in the area, and
- aspects of your background that would be relevant to the work of the Committee.
